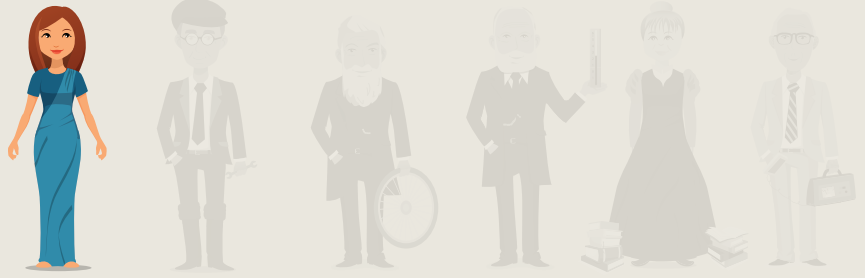

You do not have to spend all of your money but you must not go over your budget of £1000.

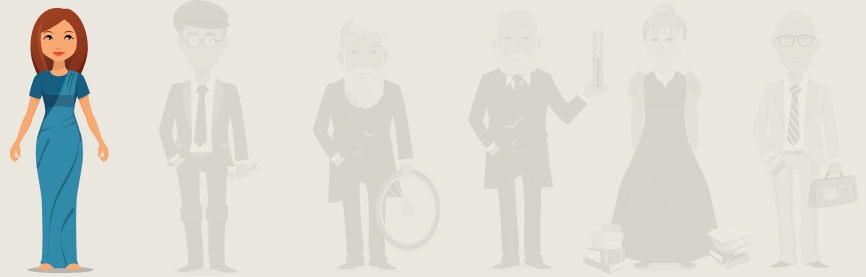
Make your decisions and give reasons for your choices.

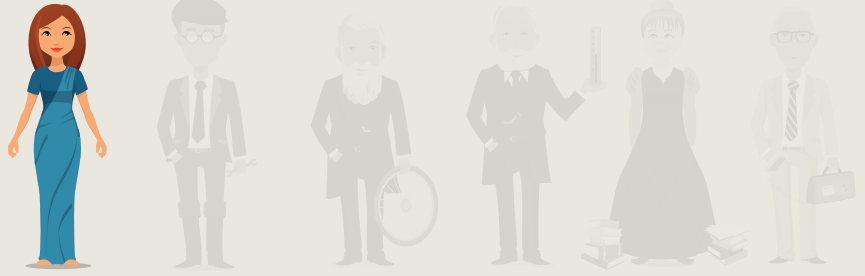

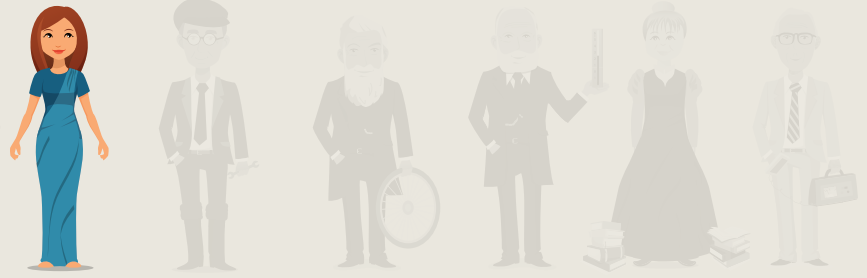
